## Dress Code at Burlington Dance Center

Our dress code ensures that our faculty will be able to see a dancer's alignment and positioning. A dress code will also teach students discipline, helping with overall focus and energy. By "dressing the part", dancers feel like dancers. Our dress code also creates unity among the dancers.

### Older Ballet Students (ages 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and up)

Black leotard, ballet pink tights, pink ballet shoes, pink pointe shoes, hair secured in a bun w/pins (*no cover up clothes in class i.e. tee shirts, sweat pants, sweatshirts*)

### Younger Ballet Students (ages 3 years-1<sup>st</sup> grade)

Black leotard, ballet pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair must be secured off the face, either a bun or ponytail for longer hair, and barrettes for short hair.

### Jazz Class

Any color leotard, black tights/leggings, black jazz shoes, (*no booty shorts, no baggy clothes such as tee shirts, sweat pants*)

### Boy's Ballet

Black tights, white socks, white ballet shoes, white crew neck tee shirt.
